Our Core Values

The Transforming Power of God's Word - We prioritize learning and applying the principles of scripture because it teaches us truth and empowers genuine change in our everyday lives.

But when some became stubborn and continued in unbelief, speaking evil of the Way before the congregation, he withdrew from them and took the disciples with him, reasoning daily in the hall of Tyrannus. This continued for two years, so that all the residents of Asia heard the word of the Lord, both Jews and Greeks." Acts 19:1, 8-10
